



## **VEX Robotics SLC Tournament**

**TSA sponsored VEX event for affiliated TSA Chapters only.**

### **Registration process:**

Step 1: **Your school MUST already be registered with Robot Events.com for the 2018-19 season and have a Team number assigned to them to compete at the State Leadership Conference.**

**Do not attempt to register your team for the State Conference VEX Competition through RobotEvents.com**

### **Step 2: Register for the State Leadership Conference Tournament:**

- **You will register through the on-line GATSA Event Management System**
- **ONLY OUR personnel will enter all registered teams on Robot Events.** *Any team registering that is found not registered with Robot Events for 18-19 will be dropped from the tournament at that point.*
- *The Georgia TSA State Leadership and Competitive Events Conference VEX Event occurs after the VEX State Championship Tournament, **but it is THE Qualifier to compete at the National TSA Conference in National Harbor, MD in June 2019.** Three schools from Georgia will represent our state there. The top three from the state tournament will own the slots unless one or more can't attend. The spot will be offered to the next team in order of finish until we have all three slots filled.*
- **For the VEX Robotics Event at the 2019 State Leadership Conference, we will be executing the format used by the National TSA Event. No pits will be assigned for the first phase.** In this event, your teams will compete in 1 Driver Skills and 1 Programming Skills match. These scores will be added together and then all teams present will be ranked from greatest to least based on their scores from the Skills matches. Teams qualifying for the Tournament will then receive their Pit Pass. A standard tournament bracket will be created from the rankings and each team will compete 1 on 1 through the bracket until we have a winner.

**There will be NO alliance selection and NO qualification matches.** This will allow us to send the correct number of robots to the Top 10 for SLC and the correct number of robots to the National Conference.
